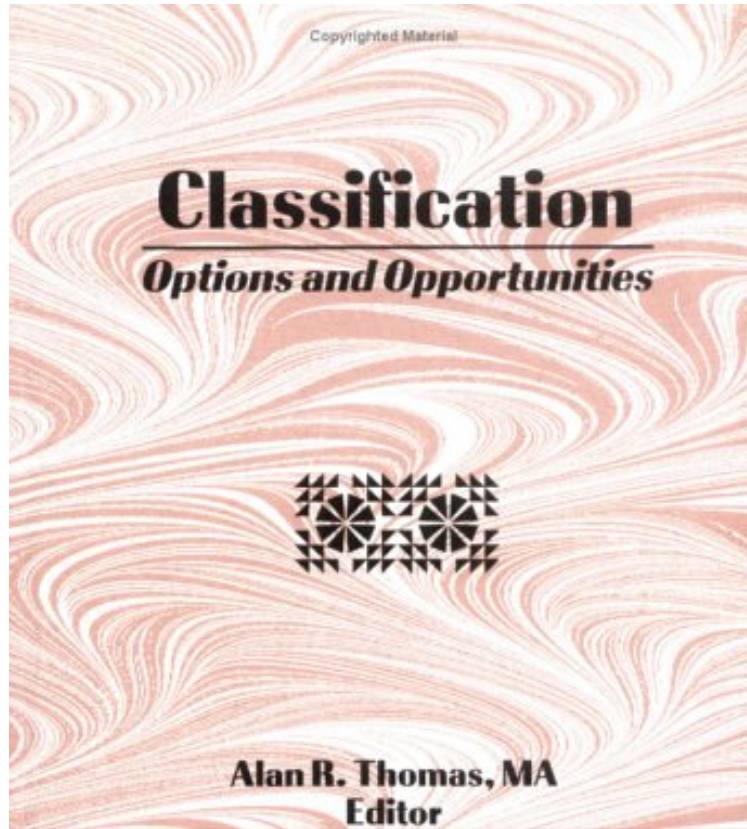

It provides detailed descriptions of alternative provisions in the much-used Dewey Decimal and Library of Congress classification systems, as well as descriptions and discussions of several alternative systems, such as Bliss Bibliographic, Universal Decimal, and Reader-Interest. The book also treats the use of multiple classification

systems within the same library. Classification: Options and Opportunities helps librarians determine which classification system to adopt and which options within the system to utilize. By selecting that solution most appropriate to their particular library or information center, library staff can make their facilities more efficient, saving time and energy for both staff and patrons.
