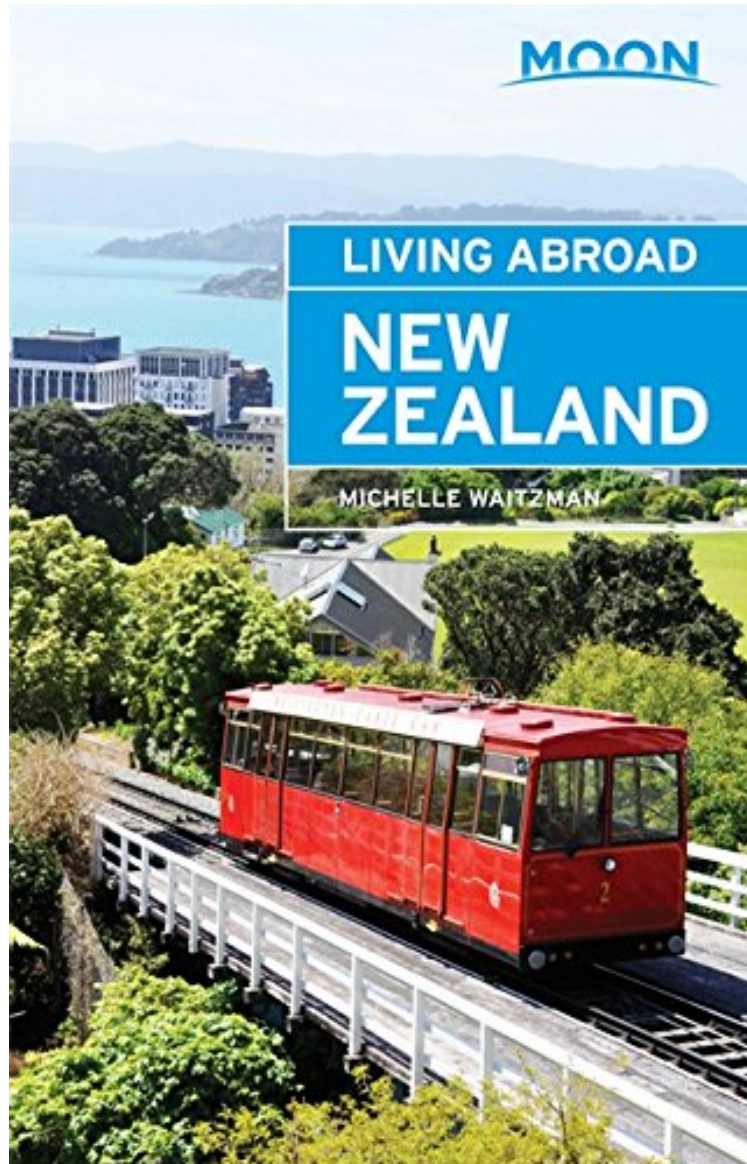

The first 70+ pages are an orientation, with about 20 pp devoted to planning your fact-finding trip. (Yes, it recommends you check out NZ before making a move.) The Daily Life section covers topics such as Making the Move, Housing Considerations, Language and Education, Health (and Health Care), Employment, Finance, Communication, Travel and Transportation. The Prime Living Locations section discusses in detail different areas of the country.
