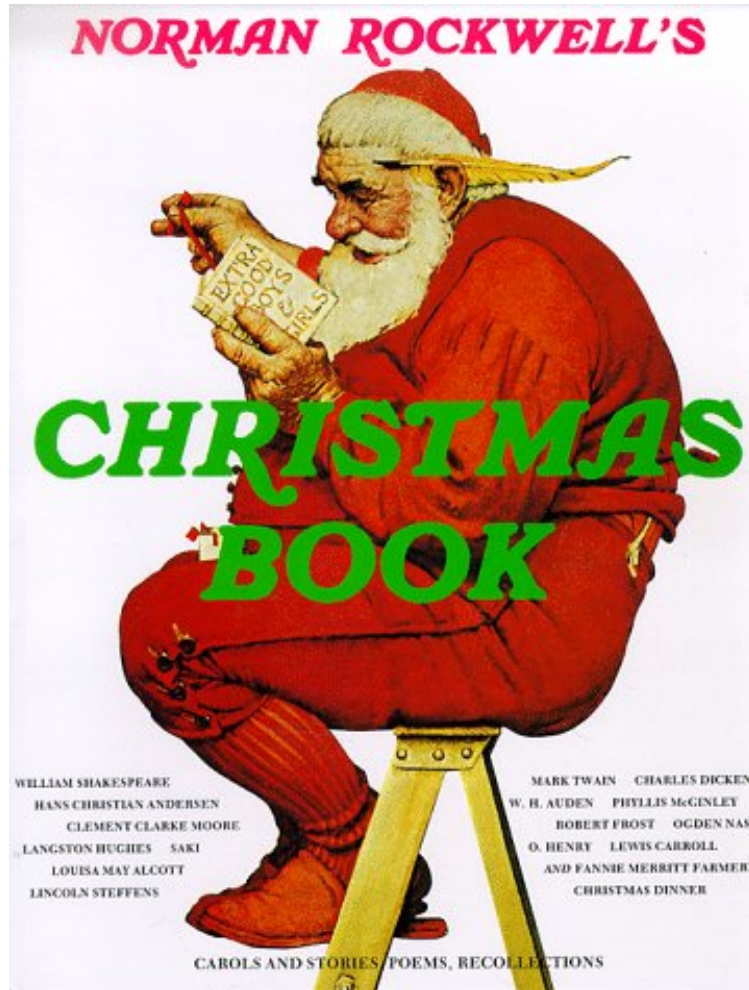

Also, there are some very nice stories which kids can read, not just grown-ups. And, as a long-time piano teacher and Church musician, with a large library of Christmas music, I can tell you that the arrangements for the Christmas music are really nice and interesting, but at a level that an intermediate piano player can easily sit down and play, and in a range for most voices to comfortably sing, so great for group singing too. We have given it to most of our children (there are just a few who don't appreciate Rockwell, but their kids grabbed up the book and spent a long time with it!).
