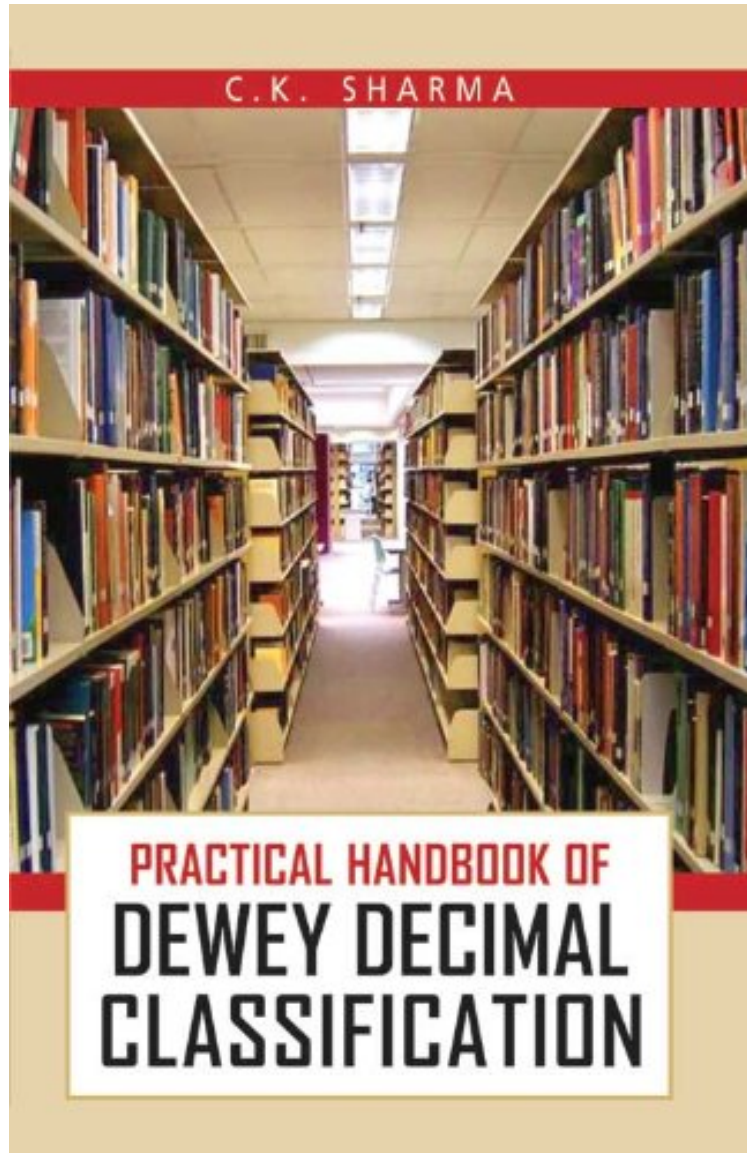

This book was no help at all. It appeared to me to be more of a collection of notes a college student would have written down during a lecture, rather than a cohesive, informative,

"practical handbook" as the title promised.

It is expected from all professionals, paraprofessionals, and library students to at least have a working knowledge of cataloguing basics, particularly the DDC, owing to its extensive application in almost all the Indian libraries.
