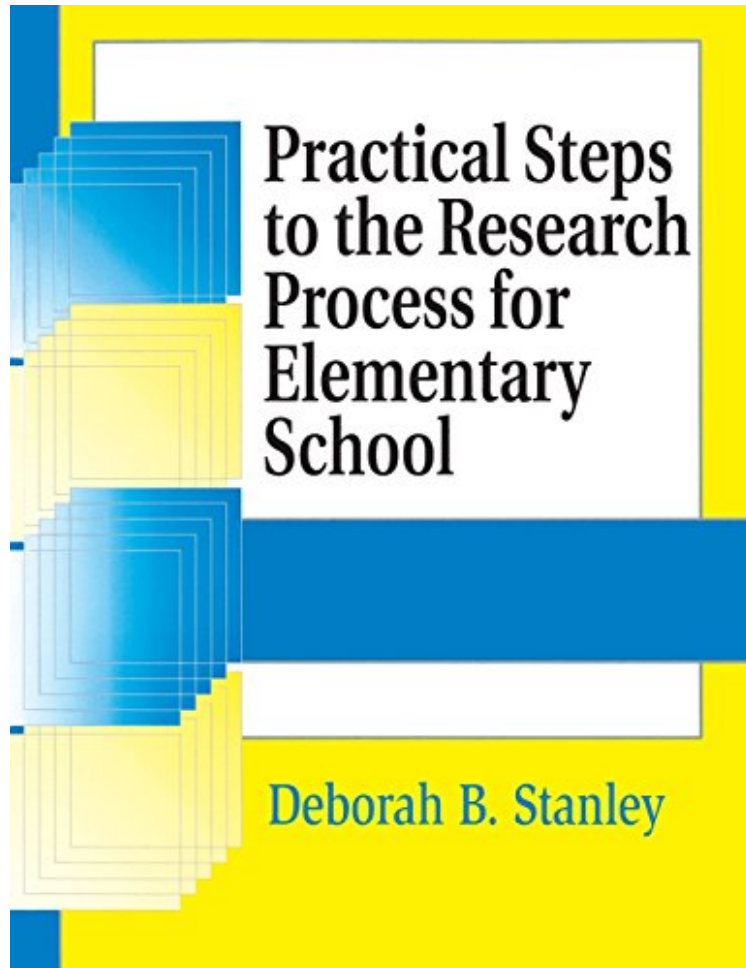

Chapters on research, emphasizing process over product, are divided into lessons for primary (K-3) and intermediate (4-6) classes, and include notetaking and writing a research paper.
