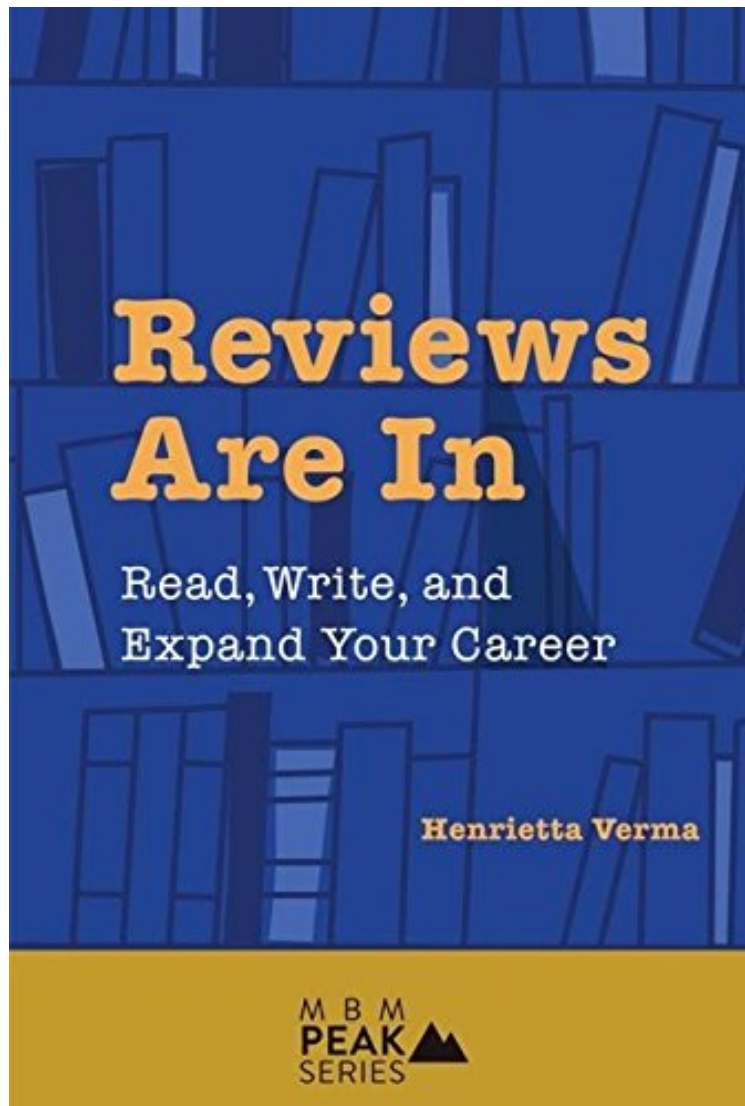

book reviewing. There are 14 separate chapters on reviewing material (both fiction and nonfiction) for adults, children and teens, and reviewing multimedia. Throughout the book, Verma's extensive experience is clear, but she also profiles and consults other library professionals. This guide is a must-read for librarians interested in book reviewing, and the information on library leadership here make this an excellent companion to Brad Hooper's *Writing Reviews for Readers Advisory* (2010), which purely covers process and technique.
