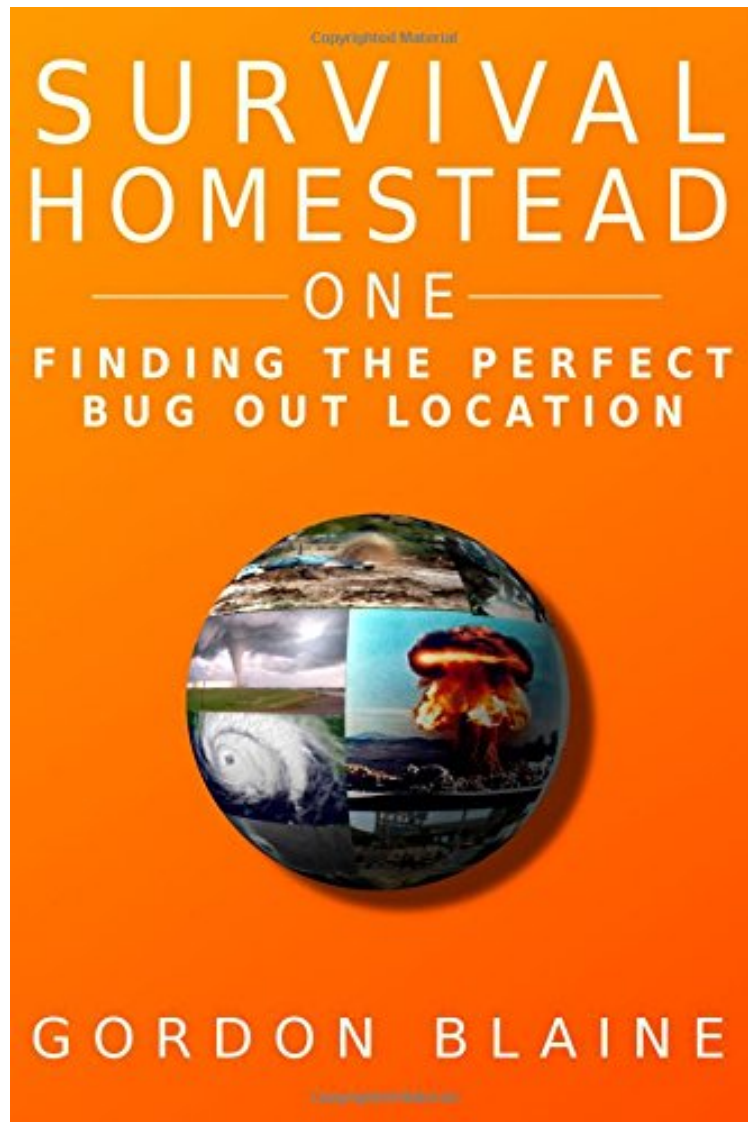

locations, I found this book to be thorough and easy to read. The author Gordon Blaine takes you step-by-step through the why, what, when where of bug out locations and the various requirements that may be needed to survive. In Part Three, using both charts and maps, the author ranks each state on various criteria, such as climate, temperature, renewable energy, precipitation, crime, etc., as well as a total state scores. Lastly, he shares insightful tips on how to search for, investigate, and check out the land you want to purchase. A solid introductory work to the monumental task of selecting your BOL! By Customer Although focussed on Americans and the USA, it was an interesting and useful read for myself as a Canadian also. It is somewhat reminiscent of "Strategic Relocation" by Joel Skousen although with far less (some might say irrelevant) commentary. The maps were colorful, easy-to-read, and useful. The analysis seems to cover most of the basics, although I may have preferred a bit more detail in the "list of 15 things" to consider when choosing a BOL / retreat location. As one example, why was the number "5 acres" chosen? Of course, the ability to plan a homestead (including outbuildings) requires a certain minimal area (which depends on the type of terrain / ease off building), but what about requirements for wind farming, agriculture, animal husbandry, forest lot / wood production (some estimates states 10 acres just in TREES), security requirements (i.e. forested perimeter for privacy / obscurity and a "clear zone" around habitations for fire break and field of fire purposes)? In summary, a good introduction to the subject. Readable, entertaining, with some good info, but a bit lacking in detail and academic rigor (good references for some government and NGO websites, but not much in terms of serious monographs or research articles, and some of the sources (e.g. Guns and Ammo magazine) probably did not add much credibility). From what I know about the author, he seems like a genuine, diligent, and thoughtful man. I definitely intend to support continued writing from such sources - so much of the survival / prepper / zombie apocalypse "literature" seems populated by extremist curmudgeons (although sadly, I may turn into one of those myself in the not too distant future).

Do you need a place to hole up and and wait out the zombie apocalypse? Where will you take your family when the financial system collapses? Are you looking for a safe place to go after the upcoming "Great Solar Flare of 2016", but your wife or girlfriend thinks you're nuts? Maybe you just want to find out where to start a sustainable Survival Homestead? Finally, an objective, scientific study on what areas make the best Bug Out Locations to help you in choosing where to flee after Iran builds a nuclear bomb. Filled with dozens of tables and full color maps, this book ranks all fifty states in thirteen categories to find out which area is most suited as a place to look for land to build the perfect Bug Out Location or Survival Homestead.
