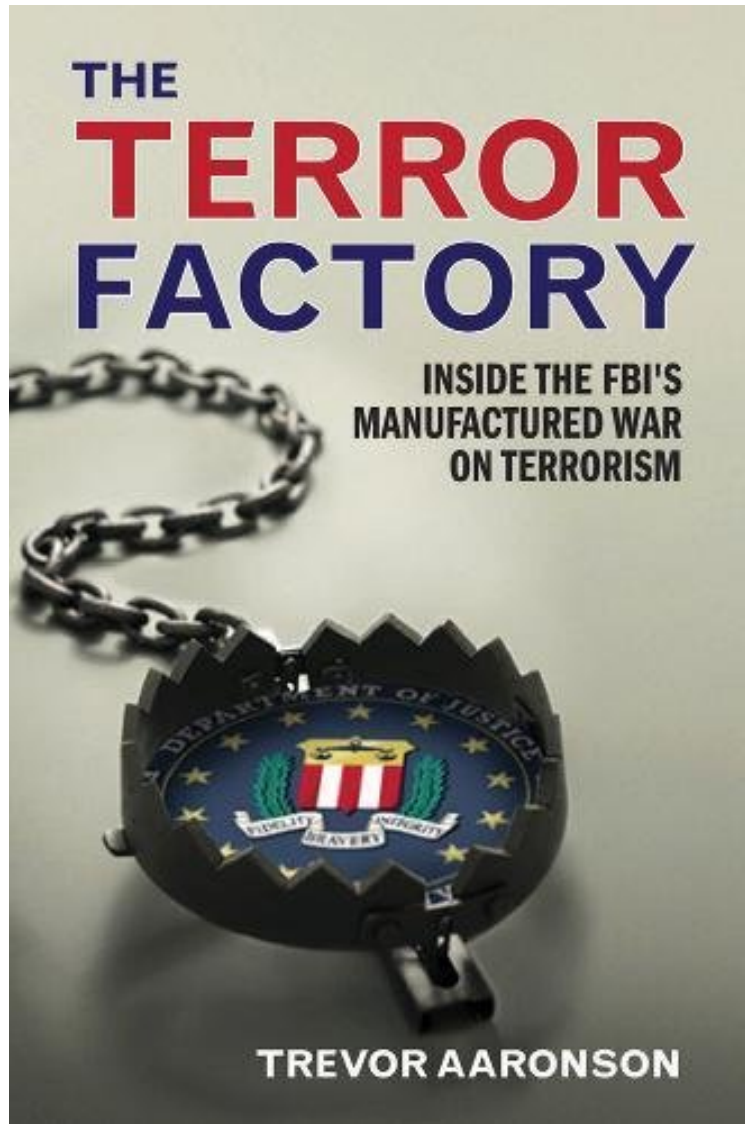

the FBI has a wide spread practice of entrapping people into terrorist schemes. Essentially, the FBI is now in the business of making terrorists. Aaronson details a number of cases in which purported terrorists were approached by informants who suggested a plan, encouraged participation, and provided material support for it. Some of these cases were in the national media, but you get a much fuller picture of the FBI role in those case than what was presented by most media outlets at the time. I was left with the impression that the resources and energy of the FBI are being wasted on setting up people who had no inclination towards terrorism prior to FBI involvement, and who had no ability to carry out an act of terrorism, i.e. funding or connections with international terrorist organizations. I read this book shortly after the Boston Marathon bombing.
