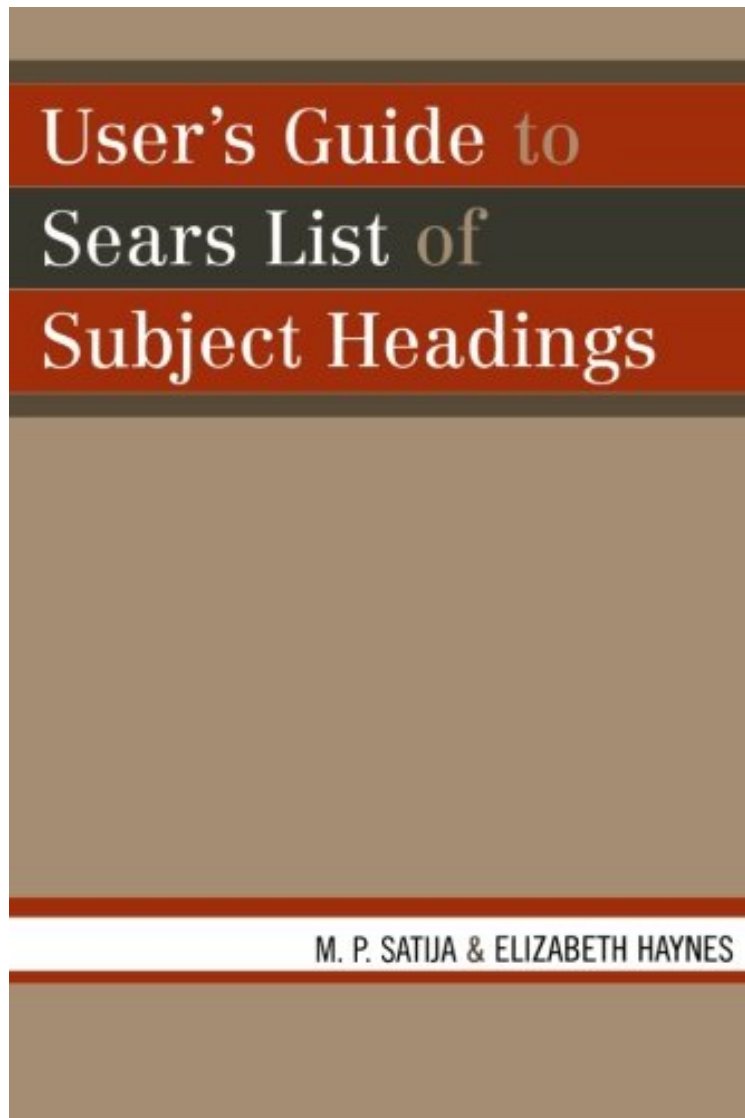

Its enduring appeal lies in part on its emphasis on specific and direct subject entries, its acceptance of common words as subject headings, and its use of key headings to guide catalogers in creating new headings.
