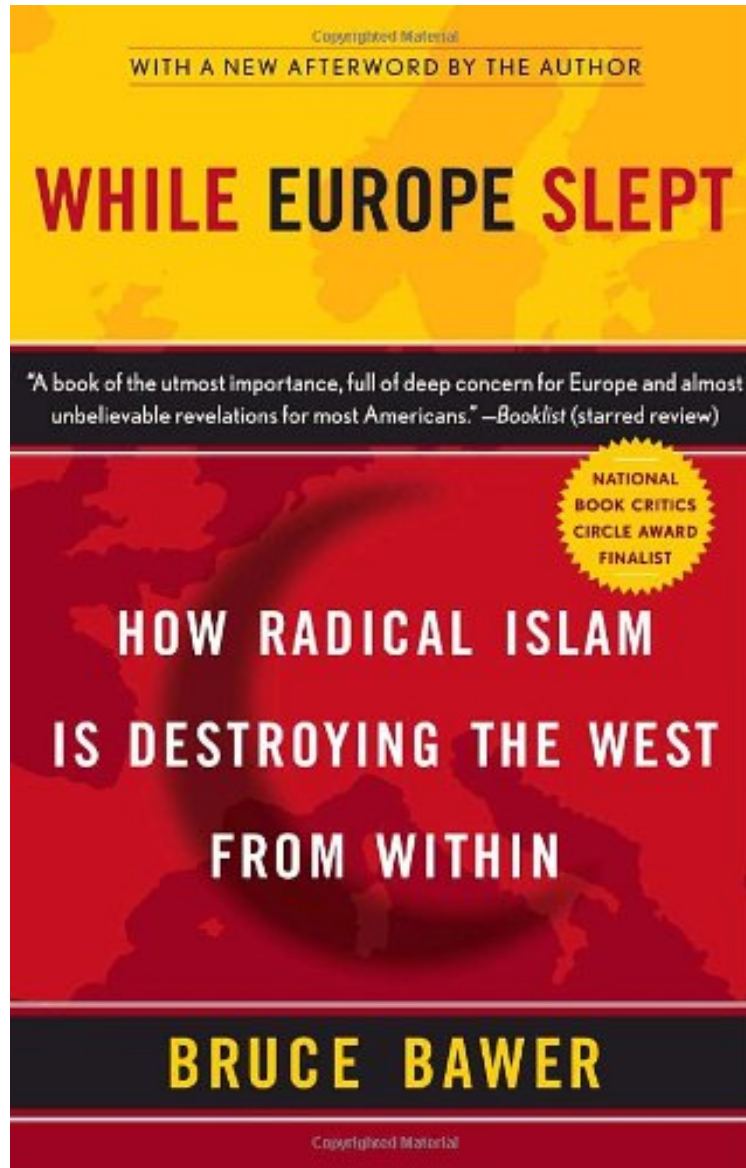

Reader I bought this book without much investigation, basing my purchase primarily on the title and desire for more knowledge on the subject that title described. I was initially dismayed by the author's liberal slant in the beginning, but as I always strive to read opinions from all sides, I resolved to slog through the book...and I am glad I did. Mr. Bawer's opinions evolved as the book went on. He is not a right wing conservative who identified a subject he wanted to write about; rather, he was an American who was unhappy with some of the aspects of his country and thought he had discovered a paradise in Europe (specifically Amsterdam) and moved there, only to find Europe was changing. His book details his thoughts of how the paradise he loved was rapidly disappearing through the refusal of the continent's inhabitants to prevent its mutation. The book is broken into three large chapters, the final chapter dealing specifically with the subject of radical Islam and how it is destroying the fabric of European life. The first two chapters are written in a stream of consciousness style, as the author wanders from one subject to another and then back again. Much of these first two chapters deal more with the author's evolving opinions (my impression, not the author actively stating this). However, while I would have preferred the facts to be presented in a different manner, I could not stop reading. Mr. Bawer went into great detail on how Europeans think, which helped greatly to explain some of their views concerning America as well as why many of them are ignoring the danger they are facing from radical Islam. The author takes great pains to separate moderate Muslims from radical Islamists and paints a fair picture of everyone involved, pulling no punches when he feels that politicians or activists are out of line or misrepresenting (or ignoring) the facts. Even though this book was written ten years ago, much of it is still informative and serves as a warning concerning events that are still happening in today's world.

What is more interesting is that when I speak to many intelligent ladies and fellows they also have not read Mr. Bawer. Certainly he is not as well known as some fictional writers who are so popular but in my opinion contribute nothing to the well being of the human animal. So much "literature" is written and sells well that really is nothing more than a distraction from living and to me has no value. Best Sellers indeed! Not to me. Now and then you will come across an author like Bruce Bawer who has an interesting life, a razor sharp perception and valuable information that you ignore at your peril. He also seems to have something that is unfortunately in short supply in this world, Courage. Particularly Courage of your convictions. SO, I read While Europe Slept and like many of my favorite books which I have reviewed I read it twenty times or so over the couple of years it came to my attention. I still enjoy it. It is the story of cultural, legal and internal violence against Europe by Islamic thought and Islamic believers. It is the story of the failure of Europe to understand, accept and meet this threat to its own people and way of life. This book is fast paced, rapidly taking you from one incident to another always with commentary offering the author's perspective. Contrary to the opinion of other reviewers I believe the incidents are sufficiently documented and described to confirm authenticity. Most dramatically the book brings into focus the Islamic attack upon a fundamental human right so long and painfully fought for and which any loss or diminishment of has consequences beyond predictability. That right is Freedom of Speech and of the Press. The violence and destruction brought into view by Mr. Bawer when viewed through his lens of the threat to Freedom of Speech and the Press brings the danger to our way of life as a fire to our face. This is not a political or religious question. It is a question of our self definition of what it means to be human and communicate and speak. In order for me to accept a book as valuable it must have certain features such as being well written in the sense of communicating ideas clearly. While some of my scientific and medical books may require me to read a passage or sentence many times to fully understand it, because I am a slow learner, a book such as While Europe Slept should flow easily in the mind and be understandable on first read. Mr. Bawer has certainly done that and done it well. While Europe Slept is a current event of how the civilization that we know of as Europe is allowing itself to be destroyed by fellow human beings who hate and despise it. Yes a little strange, but when a nation such as France or England or Germany etc., allows many new immigrants, legal and illegal to take up residence and yet reject, despise and hate their new country we should ask why? Adolf Hitler almost destroyed European Civilization and he was native born. But in the act of destruction by Hitler, Europe had to confront itself and its contradictions. At the end of World War 2, those issues and choices were settled and Europe survived. The United States had rescued Europe from itself. As the years went on Europe arose from the ashes of war to become a beacon of light again. NOW, Europe is faced with the strange anomaly of destruction from within. It is strange not because of the damage caused by a foreign Islamic people who hate Europe, as that is just a part of life. What is strange is the apparent acquiescence of the European nations and

people to their own internal end, an end of their language, law and cultural heritage. How could this be?? Bruce Bawer tells this timely story by a combination of his personal experience, his survey of news reports, and his analysis of what he perceives with his own eyes and hears. It rings true. As the author shows Europe is under attack and it is a overt violent confrontation with the ability of Europeans to function and live from day to day. There is no subtlety here. There is an obvious announcement and course of conduct to undermine and destroy the legal protections that define European Civilization and Western Civilization itself. The descriptions of Islamic cultural onslaught in Europe with full acquiescence of the governments and people of Europe cannot be disputed. Bruce Bawer gives insights into the European mind that are readily available to anyone who took the time and effort to look. The struggle for the soul of Europe today is every bit as dire and consequential as it was in the 1930s. Then, in Weimar, Germany, the center did not hold, and the light of civilization nearly went out. Today, the continent has entered yet another Weimar moment. From Booklist *Starred* When cultural journalist Bawer moved to the Netherlands and then Norway, he found societies in which tolerance and civility were ubiquitous and social services provided from cradle to grave. But he soon discovered smug, ill-informed anti-Americanism, especially

among politicians, academics, and the media, and a stifling political correctness that allowed biting the hand that feeds as long as the fed could claim minority status. Particularly alarming was the fact that Muslims were never criticized, Muslim-committed crimes largely overlooked. Brought to trial, Muslims were often acquitted on peculiar grounds and enjoyed all of Western Europe's welfare, which they take disproportionately to their numbers, including government subsidization of mosques. Bawer cites instance after instance to bolster his contention that Western Europe is on the brink of losing Western European ways of life, beginning with personal liberties. He hopes for a liberal reaction that will get tough with the enormously bold, bullying Islamic fundamentalists, who seem to have utterly cowed the so-called moderate Islamic majority. He fears fundamentalist Islamicization of Western Europe or, instead, the reemergence of racist fascism.
